I am SO EXCITED for this year's Spring shows! The "little's (and not-so-littles) presentation of Under The Big Top is one of my favorites with so many props and such fun costumes. This year's upper school ballet is The Forest and rounding out our spring dance celebration is All That Jazz 2019. The teachers have been working so hard with all of the students, encouraging them to always reach for more, to do their best, to support each other and have lots of fun along the way! Enclosed is everything you need to know for our upcoming year-end performance ~ a.k.a "*Wilton Dance Studio's Performance Show Packet.*"

**TICKETS & DIGITAL DOWNLOAD: NEW THIS YEAR** – Each family participating this year has been charged a Performance Fee. This fee INCLUDES unlimited digital downloads of the performance and TWO FREE TICKETS to one performance, **additional tickets are ONLY \$10 when bought in advance (\$15 at the day of the performance).** To receive your free tickets you must fill out and return the ticket order form by **May 23rd.**

**Which show is my child in?** Carefully look at the lists on page 3 of this packet. We are presenting two shows with most classes performing in one or the other. However, that a couple of the classes will be invited to participate in both.

**REMINDER:** *If you have a dancer who has three or more dances in the second half of the 3:00 pm show (All That Jazz—classes include Contemporary, Tap, Jazz, Hip Hop, Acro and Team) a MOM is required to be backstage during the dress rehearsal and performance to help with their child's quick changes. This is necessary because if you only show up for the performances to "assist" then you are actually hindering the process more than helping.*

**Our Photo Days** took place on Wednesday, May 1st at Wilton Dance Studio. A class photo was taken as well as individual poses. (You are under no obligation to purchase any of the photos.) **Donner Photographic's representatives will have the finished photos for you to view and purchase on Wednesday, May 8th from 4:30- 8:30 pm at the studio.**

**Parents of all dancers—Question:** Do you ever wonder how we make your children look so good on stage? It's not an accident—we have help. Lots of it from parents. ***We need you!!*** Each class needs one or two **Group Moms** to help us keep track of all those energetic dancers backstage. Your commitment to us would be for the dress rehearsal on June 1st and the show on June 2nd. It's a great opportunity to support your child in addition to having an *insider's* peek at all the behind-the-scenes action! Please note that **ONLY** registered volunteers will be allowed backstage during the performances. We greatly appreciate your cooperation with this matter.

**Parents of "Tweens" & Teens:** I know you don't think your child needs a "baby sitter" at their age. But past experience tells us that they definitely need some adult supervision backstage. **Please help by being a volunteer.**

**Costumes:** Please hang them neatly in a safe place—no "dress up" yet! **If you have not yet paid for your costume or still have an outstanding balance, please remit as the costumes will only be released to accounts that are current.** It is your responsibility to make sure your account is in good standing. You can check your account anytime through your on-line access. Not sure how to log on? Email [mark@wiltondance.com](mailto:mark@wiltondance.com) and he will walk you through the process. Thank you for your understanding.

**A Suggestion:** Try to find a quiet time and place to review the following pages. I know there's a lot to absorb. We've enclosed a Flow Chart to help you make sense of it all. If, after you have read through the enclosed you still have questions, please do not hesitate to call or email me. The teachers are great at what they do, but the show details **are not** their responsibility. However, do look to them for details on hair, tights & any costume notes. Please address the office regarding all other show issues.

## **Dress Rehearsal Schedule - Saturday, June 1st** **Location: Wilton High School Auditorium, Wilton, CT**

If possible wear your costume to the theater. Remember that dance shoes are not to be worn outside. Put your name on EVERYTHING you bring to the theater. Do **NOT** bring anything to the theater that you will miss if it gets lost. Please quietly enter the theater, look at the end of the aisles for seat assignment and wait for further instructions from staff. Since a rehearsal will be finishing as you arrive, please wait quietly in your seat. Please make sure that ANYTHING you bring to the theater (including costumes and shoes) has your child's name inside. Yes, I know I repeated myself, it's that important. Thank you! **Important Theatre Etiquette Reminder: No food or drink of any kind is allowed inside theater - EVER!!**

Theaters are *very special* places and must be treated with respect.

Parents, Rehearsal Note: This is a tight time schedule. We work hard to ensure that we keep on time. As I need to stay focused on your children, please do not ask questions of me during this rehearsal. *Thanks!*

# DRESS REHEARSAL & PERFORMANCE INFORMATION & SCHEDULE

Here is a summary of our dress rehearsal, performance schedule, costume and make-up needs. First, we ask for your patience and cooperation during the rehearsal process. There will be some confusion, technical glitches, and delays. Still we will try hard to start and end rehearsals on time. We need your support by arriving on time and remaining at the theater until you are dismissed.

Dancers **MUST** attend the Dress Rehearsal! This is necessary to familiarize them with the stage, learn where entrances and exits are, find the dressing room and rest rooms. **ANYONE NOT ATTENDING THE DRESS REHEARSAL WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO APPEAR IN THE PERFORMANCE.** This is for the safety of all of the dancers.

Also, please let us know if you have any questions or concerns. Many thanks.

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**NO FOOD, NO DRINKS, NO CHEWING GUM IN THE AUDITORIUM DURING REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES. NO SODA OR COLORED JUICE.** Dancers rehearsing **multiple shows** on the same day should bring water and a nutritious snack to be eaten only during announced break. Absolutely no food or drink of any kind is allowed in the auditorium or on the stage. Dancers should bring a beach cover-up, robe, or an over-sized shirt to wear over their costume to prevent soiling.

**COSTUME:** Wear costume, tights. Carry dance shoes. Write first and last name on every piece of costume and clothing, in both shoes, and on everything which the dancer will take to the theater. Students in more than one dance: put all shoes and costumes in a shopping bag clearly marked with the dancer's name (each dancer needs his/her own bag). On the outside of the bag, list items to be found in the bag. This may prevent misplacing articles.

**HAIR:** Fix dancer's hair before coming to the theater. Plain barrettes that match color of student's hair and are non reflective. **NO** headbands. All hair should be pulled away from the face, and long hair put in a bun on the back of the head. Hair will stay neatly in place if lightly sprayed with hair spray. Cover bun with a fine hair net and securely pin it in place. **HAIR NETS ARE THE SECRET OF HAIR STAYING IN A BUN AND STAYING NEAT.** Short hair should be pulled away from face and **HEAVILY SPRAYED** to keep it in place. Another little known hint is that dirty hair is easier to pull back and put up than clean hair! The above applies to all dancers unless their teacher gives them a special hair style in keeping with the period of the dance. Stage lights tend to cast shadows, and bangs will obscure the face and put the eyes into a shadow. So, please pull the hair off the face so that we (and you) may see your child's beautiful eyes.

**STAGE:** Do not go up on stage prior to being called. **PARENTS AND VOLUNTEERS:** Do not walk across or up onto the stage with street shoes. We lay down a special flooring that could be damaged by footwear other than **DANCE** shoes.

**MAKE-UP:** Apply make-up at home. Clear red lipstick (not frosted) on everyone, brown eyebrow pencil if eyebrows are light. Eyeshadow: a complimentary color to your skin tone (no blue or aqua). Black or dark brown eyeliner and mascara. Rouge: small amount high on the cheekbones. Make-up is necessary because the strong stage lights wash out the faces which do not have make-up.

**NO JEWELRY OF ANY KIND. NO watches or Fitbits.** Please don't bring them to the auditorium.

**NO PANTIES (underwear).** They hang down and show under tights.

**NO NAIL POLISH, TEMPORARY TATTOOS OR COLORED BANDAIDS.**

**PARENTS:** Please do not stay to watch during the dress rehearsal - unless you are videotaping. Because we know you want to zoom in on your own child, we will allow one parent at the dress rehearsal to photograph or videotape. Also please, no friends or siblings at the rehearsals. **NO ONE EXCEPT PERFORMERS.** We want the finished product to be a SURPRISE! Please help us keep the magic! The exceptions are the *Under The Big Top* Performers...you may stay, but please sit away from your child's class so as not to distract them.

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**PERFORMANCE:** Sunday, June 2nd at 1:00 pm & 3:00 pm - Wilton HS Auditorium  
Dancers arrive one hour before show-time and report to backstage area.  
Ballet VIIb, V, VI & Team arrive **11:00 am** for a stage-barre.  
**Under the Big Top** dancers should arrive at 30 minutes prior to the performance time and go to their theater seats.

**COSTUME/MAKE-UP:** Exactly the same as described in "DRESS REHEARSAL" above.

**DINNER** (for those dancers who are in more than one show): WDS and all related activities are NUT FREE events. No Peanuts or Tree Nuts - Thank you!!! Please remember to send a robe or large shirt to completely cover your child's costume & tights. Pack them a sack dinner/lunch and please send water, no soda or colored juice. Think about what would be the "least messy" foods to send. Your child will appreciate it, the child sitting next to them will appreciate it and so will we! Please send only one parent backstage to be with your child at the dinner break. Please make sure your child is back to their assigned area and ready to perform by 2:30 pm. All parents are asked to leave at this time so that the dancers can begin to refocus back on the performance - unless of course, you are the group parent - then there's no escape for you!!

**PARENTS: Do not go into the dressing room or backstage areas during the performance or during the intermission.** We have volunteers backstage to care for all the dancers during the performance. Everyone will be taken care of. Please do not bring your child into the auditorium after they perform because they are needed to appear in the FINALE. Children going back and forth into the auditorium during the show disturb the performance and annoy the people sitting around you. Also, volunteers spend valuable time looking for your child. Parents going into the dressing room/waiting area only causes the dancers to become anxious and nervous. Your child needs you out front to applaud. If you are willing and able to volunteer as a "Backstage Parent," please be sure to fill out a volunteer form, and THANKS! We truly appreciate your cooperation and support in making this a smooth running show.

**PHOTOGRAPHS:** I know you want pictures of your child performing, so we will be filming the entire show which every family will receive access to a digital download and a professional dance photographer will take photos at the studio. See attached Photo Day schedule.

**WE CAN NOT LET INDIVIDUALS TAKE PICTURES OF ANY KIND DURING THE PERFORMANCE.** PLEASE inform your invited guests of this rule. The reason for this rule is that THE FLASH GOING OFF OR SEEING A PHONE/TABLET BEING HELD UP FILMING IS DISTRACTING AND VERY DANGEROUS FOR THE PERFORMER'S. Momentarily blinded or distracted, a dancer could seriously injure themselves if they fall. We have noticed that some phones make a red or bright blue light even when the flash feature is turned off. Many dancers have complained of the distraction the flashes and these bright lights create. Therefore, picture-taking will NOT be permitted during the show. Also, the use of digital/video cameras and phones/tablets in the audience is distracting to people sitting around you. Please, just enjoy the show, and applaud your dancer. The camera crew will capture it all AND you get a digital download of the show as part of your performance package!. Your cooperation is GREATLY APPRECIATE!

**Group Mom Duties:** Supervise children, help with costume changes and any make-up that needs attention. Accompany your group to the stage when called by the stage manager. You may slip into the auditorium to see your group perform, but we need you to meet the class when it exits the stage, take them to the backstage area and stay with them during the entire performance. You may want to also bring an age-appropriate quiet activity that’s not messy, a book to read, etc.

### \_\_\_\_\_ **MAKE-UP & HAIR:** (2 or 3 per show)

Time commitment - Dress Rehearsal and Performance, arrive early on performance day.

Duties - We supply the make-up and teach you what to do. Most children should arrive with the majority of their make-up and hair already done. You may be needed to neaten hair, fix buns and make sure dancers have a “similar” look. When dancers are ready, you are free to watch the show.

# VOLUNTEER FORM, CONT.

\_\_\_\_\_ **STAGE CREW:** (Dads welcomed - 2 or 3 each show)

Time commitment - Dress rehearsal, tech rehearsal and both performances.

Duties: Help set up flooring and hang back drops Friday evening, May 31st. Dress rehearsal times on June 1st to move any set pieces that require an adult during the show. Help with clean up after the 3:00 show "striking the set", help remove and fold back drops, roll up floor, etc. Help us pack up so that we can go home too!

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\_\_\_\_\_ **COSTUME SEAMSTRESS:**

Time commitment - As needed - we will need your patience & flexibility since deadlines are involved.

Duties: Sew sequins, ribbons, whatever.

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\_\_\_\_\_ **HOUSE MANAGER:** (Dads welcomed)

Time commitment - Performance.

Duties: Hang around in the back of the auditorium just after the show starts and quietly let latecomers inside the darkened theater. Make sure doors are quietly opened and closed.

Time commitment - 1/2 hour prior to show start time.

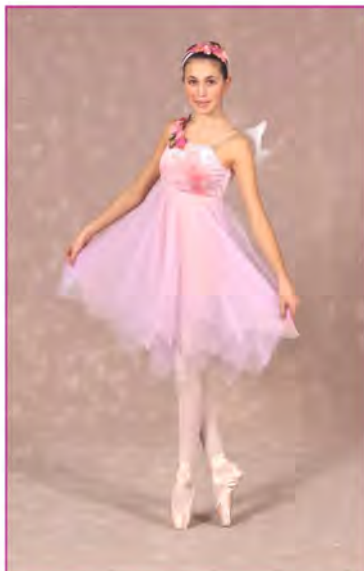

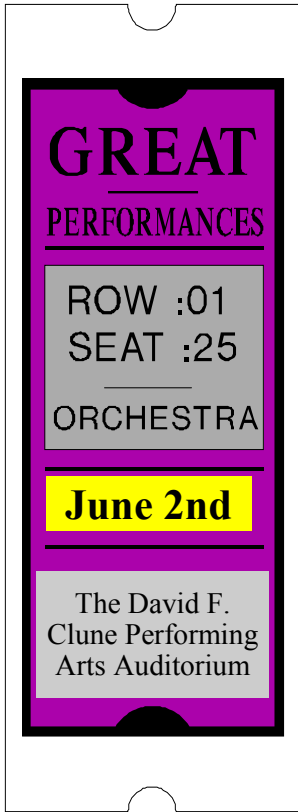
